The International Union Pure and Applied Chemistry (IUPAC) is the world authority on chemical nomenclature and terminology, including the naming of new elements in the periodic table: on standardized methods for measurement, and on atomic weights, and many other critically-evaluated data.

A neutral and objective scientific organization, IUPAC was established in 1919 by academic and industrial chemists who shared a common goal-to unite a fragmented, global chemistry community for the advancement of the chemical sciences via collaboration and the free exchange of scientific information.

GWB was started from 2019 onwards by IUPAC. The main aim of the GWB is to demonstrate the need to build a network of both women and men working together to address the barriers and inequalities faced by women in science.
